

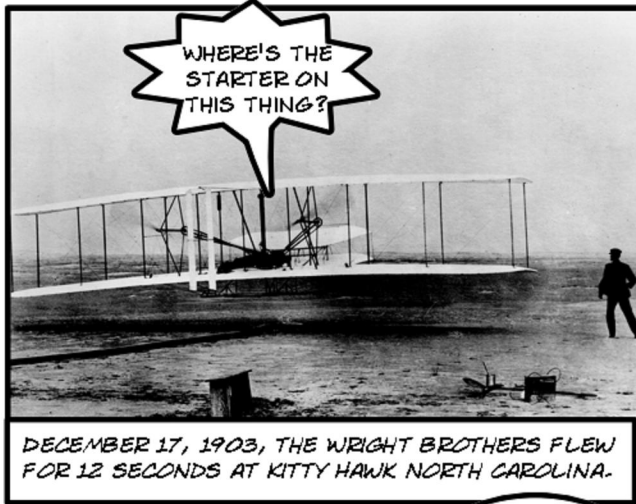

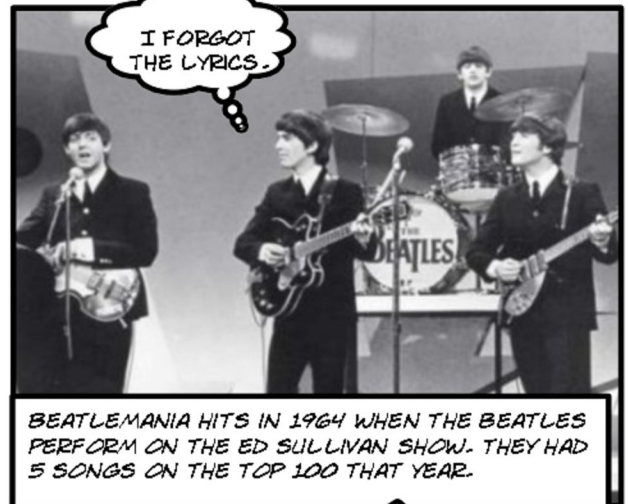

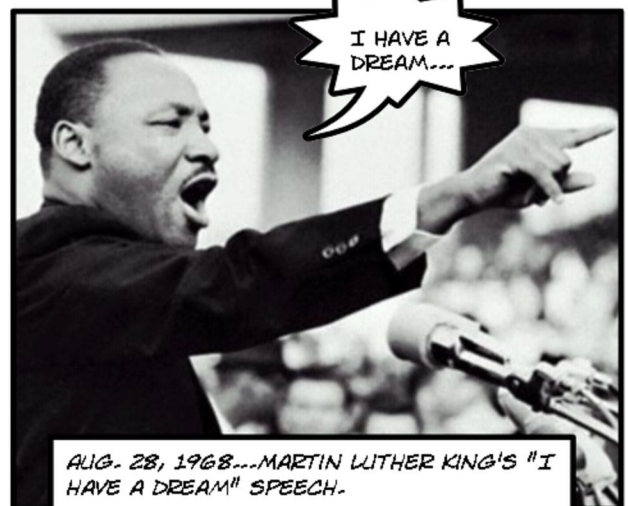
I FORGOT THE LYRICS.

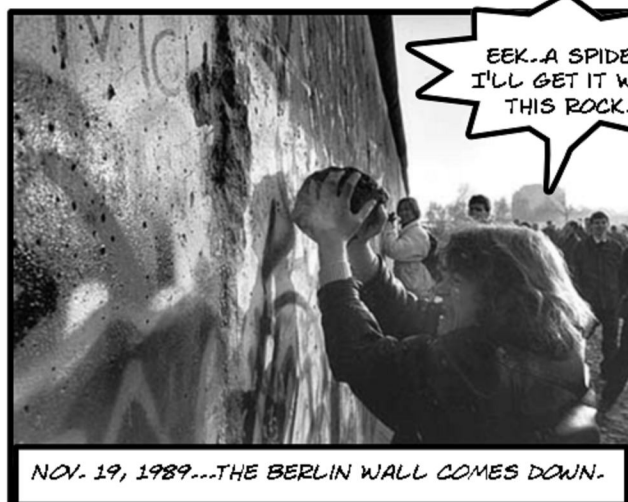
...ONE GIANT LEAP FOR MANKIND.

JULY 20, 1969...MAN WALKS ON THE MOON.



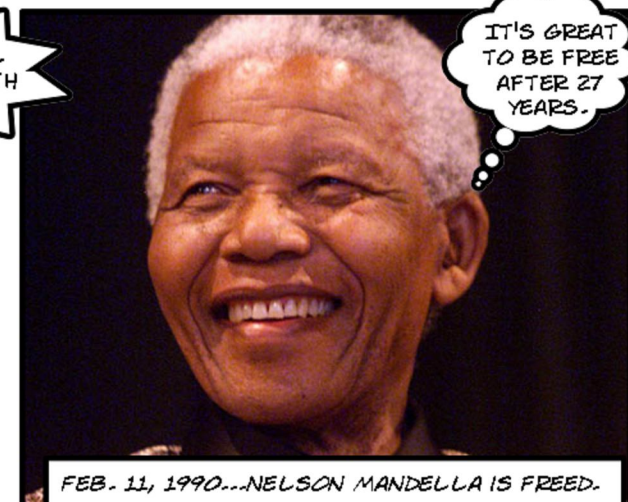
I HAVE A DREAM...
